Applications will be reviewed by the Foundation. The selected recipient(s) will be announced at the AIA Academy of Architecture for Health Update HCD conference- Orlando- November 13, 2017. The selected recipient(s) agrees to prepare a summary report of their travel experiences to the Foundation.
