- Two reference letters from faculty directly involved in the healthcare architecture program or directly involved with the student.

Applications will be reviewed by the Foundation. The selected recipient(s) will be announced at the AIA Academy of Architecture for Health Update 2018 PDC Conference in Nashville, TN.
