Resources & Environment

Facilities & Other Resources

Identify the facilities to be used (clinical, computer, office, simulation lab, or other). Ethics

Designate if human subjects are involved, and if so, whether the proposed activities meet the criteria for exemption. Applications that involve human subjects must include a Protection of Human Subjects Section that addresses the points noted below. Applications that are not proposing human subjects research but will use human data or biological specimens, must provide a justification for the claim of no involvement of human subjects.

Requirements and Responsibilities. As required by federal regulations (45 C.F.R. 46) and NIH policy, applications that propose to involve human subjects must address:

1. the risk to subjects
2. the adequacy of protections against risk
3. potential benefits of the research to subjects and others
4. the importance of the knowledge to be gained
5. For clinical trials, data and safety monitoring plan and a data and safety monitoring board for Phase III trials
